## Scoring Results 19 – Site RFP

The Henry and Rilla White Youth Foundation, Inc. publicly opened proposals received in response to Request for Proposal titled: “Request for Proposal And Contract Nonprofit School Food Service.” Pursuant to Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, the posting of this Notice of Agency Decision will commence on May 22, 2017 C.O.B and shall continue for 72 hours, excluding State holidays and weekends, until May 25, 2017 C.O.B.

The Henry and Rilla White Youth Foundation, Inc. has identified **G4S Youth Services LLC.**, for potential award of the contract.

**G4S Youth Services LLC. was the only potential provider who submitted a response to this competitive solicitation.**

Any person who is adversely affected by the decision or intended decision shall file with the Foundation a notice of protest in writing within 72 hours after the posting of the notice of decision or intended decision. With respect to a protest of the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in a solicitation, including any provisions governing the methods for ranking bids, proposals, or replies, awarding contracts, reserving rights of further negotiation, or modifying or amending any contract, the notice of protest shall be filed in writing within 72 hours after the posting of the solicitation. The written notice shall be submitted with a bond payable to The Henry and Rilla White Youth Foundation, Inc. in an amount equal to one percent of the estimate of the total value of the contract. In lieu of a bond, The Henry and Rilla White Youth Foundation, Inc. may accept a cashier’s check or a money order in the amount of the bond. Failure to file the proper bond at the time of filing the notice will result in denial of the protest. The formal written protest shall be filed within 10 days after the date the notice of protest is filed. Failure to file a notice of protest or failure to file a formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Florida Statutes 120.57. The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based. Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time periods provided by this paragraph.
